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## Pros

FREE

Wide variety of subjects are available (not just math)

Very engaging modules for students to work through independently

Students can work at own pace

Topics not offered elsewhere (Financial literacy, digital literacy)

Can track students

Engaging!

Can be used at home or school

Immediate feedback

## Cons

Some support, but can be spotty (2 years ago was great; last year my messages remain unanswered, this year looks much better again)

Cannot turn off specific activities within the assignments

Cannot be an entire program

Can be difficult to sign up your class (Easiest if YOU do it...invite by email)

More American-based

Less locked down. Teachers are "coaches"

No printable activities or books

Not as intuitive as Mathletics; not as well laid-out

Need headphones

Can't differentiate easily

Can't assign specific tasks

Less student support
