## Pros

FREE

Wide variety of subjects are available (not just math)

Large number of problems by grade level (randomly generated)

Missions—individualized math experiences grouped by grade

Can differentiate

Can use to Personalized Learning

Weekly reports (less detail)

Full Grades k-12 curriculum

Can track students

Engaging! (Badges, points, etc)

Mastery—must answer 10 correct to ad-

Can assign tasks

Can be used at home or school

Immediate feedback/mastery

Built in student support/help (hints)

Web-based and App available

2200 Videos (way more than Mathletics)

## Cons

No support other than FAQ

Cannot turn off specific activities within the assignments

Cannot be an entire program

Can be difficult to sign up your class (Easiest if YOU do it...invite by email)

American curriculum

Less locked down. Teachers are "coaches"

No printable activities or books

Not as intuitive as Mathletics; not as well laid-out

Must walk students through how to find videos and exercises

## Help & Tips!

- Sign up your students yourself, if possible. (This works best if you can invite them by email)
- Show students how to add you as a coach
- Show students how to search by subject, and how to do a specific content search.
- Try the Missions First
